

Hip Hip Basics: Scheming



Objective

Students will begin to create their own original rap compositions by using the Scheming strategy.

Key Terms

Rap Scheming: The process of improvising words that are related to a specific category. (e.g. musical instruments: trumpet, guitar, piano, etc.)

Procedures

- 1. Students will select a category (e.g. fruits, colors, etc.)
- 2. Students will then play their favorite hip hop backing track and say as many words as they can that are related to that category. (e.g. fruits = kiwi, lime, grapes, apple)
- 3. Students will then team up with a friend and take turns scheming going back and forth, saying words related to the selected category.
- 4. If doing this remote, students can take turns by doing 4 to 8 measures at a time to help with the latency.

Extension

- 1. Students who feel really comfortable with the scheming strategy can begin to repeat the process but with a faster tempo. This will make it more challenging to come up with words and say them on the beat.
- 2. Students can expand on the format by scheming with multiple people in groups of 3 or 4.
