

Lesson Title: Make Music with Soundtrap	Grade Level: 6-12
Objective(s): Students will practice three part body drumming and syncopated drum set patterns	Resources/Materials: Soundtrap Part 1 Soundtrap Part 2 Intro to Soundtrap
Procedures (Lesson steps) - Students will . . . 1. Student will log into Soundtrap (1 min) 2. Students will watch “Making Music With Soundtrap Loops” and create their own projects using loops (20 minutes) 3. Students will watch “Changing Tempo” and adjust the tempo of their project as they see fit (3 min) 4. Students will watch using a “Keyboard to Play MIDI: and record their own MIDI parts (20 minutes) 5. Students will watch “Creating a Verse and a Chorus” and make adjustments to their projects based on tips from the video (20 min)	
Reflection Questions: What are your favorite instruments to use? What makes two loops sound good together? What makes two loops sound bad together?	
Differentiation	
Expansion - Student can use the more advanced Soundtrap lessons and apply more complex techniques to their compositions. Students can share their projects with their peers.	Simplification - Students can take longer with the earlier videos and skills and focus on those, disregarding the more complex skills
